

CIRCULAR

DBS Detention policy

With this Circular Dromon Head Office would like to remind all field surveyor and auditor on our detention policy.

As per this Bureau policy, ***no vessel should be detained from PSC authorities following three (3) months after a survey has been completed.*** A survey may be:

- Class or statutory surveys irrespective of scope
- Safety management or security audits on board
- Maritime Labour Inspections
- Occasional attendances

In the unfortunate event that a vessel is detained within three (3) months after any of the above surveys have been conducted, Dromon Head Office will request an official explanation letter from the attending surveyor justifying the reasons that such a detention took place.

The Head Office will evaluate the submitted explanation letter and take necessary action as deemed necessary.

Surveyors and auditors should take this policy into serious consideration and assure that no detainable items are left on a notice of recommendation issued under QSP7.3. In case a major recommendation is imposed then Dromon Head Office should be informed to take necessary action prior issuing or endorsing any class/statutory certificate.
