The purpose of this circular is to inform all parties concerned about the approved Service Providers for lifeboats, launching appliances and on-load release gears;

- a) To remind that only approved Service Provides by this Administration shall be used to provide services to any ship flying the flag of Comoros;
- b) To remind that a Service Provider is authorized to perform maintenance, thorough examination, operational testing, overhaul and repair solely to types/models of equipment for which it holds approvals/authorizations from the manufacturer.
