Acceptance of Electronic Copies of Certificates and Documents

Applicable to: This FLEET SAFETY LETTER should be brought to the attention of ship-owners, ship managers, operators, Masters of Vanuatu-registered ships and Recognized Organizations

Copies of certificates and documents in electronic format issued by the Assistant Commissioner of Maritime Affairs and electronically communicated by any of the Vanuatu Logistics and Administration Services Limited Offices or Special Agents are acceptable in lieu of the originals until such time as the originals may be placed on board at a convenient port provided that the issue date of any copy does not exceed 90 days.

Electronic format refers to any document that can be accessed via a computer, whether stored on a hard drive, flash drive, CD, or available online. Any scanned or typed document that can be viewed digitally also qualifies as an electronic format.

Furthermore, electronic communication encompasses the transmission of data, text, images, sounds, or intelligence through various means, including wire, radio, electromagnetic, photo-electronic, or photo-optical systems.

A paper document that has been scanned and converted into a digital file is likewise considered an electronic format, making both soft copies and printed versions acceptable. In this regard, scanned copies of certificates and documents, whether in digital or printed form, are deemed valid.
